1 1 Amend Senate File 469, as passed by the Senate, as
1 2 follows:
1 3 #1. Page 4, by striking lines 13 through 26 and
1 4 inserting the following:
1 5 <c. A business creating jobs with economic
1 6 development assistance through moneys appropriated in
1 7 this subsection shall be subject to contract
1 8 provisions stating that new and retained jobs shall be
1 9 filled by individuals who are citizens of the United
1 10 States who reside within the United States or any
1 11 person authorized to work in the United States
1 12 pursuant to federal law, including legal resident
1 13 aliens in the United States. Any vendor who receives
1 14 such public moneys shall adhere to such contract
1 15 provisions and provide periodic assurances as the
1 16 state shall require that the jobs are filled solely by
1 17 citizens of the United States who reside within the
1 18 United States or any person authorized to work in the
1 19 United States pursuant to federal law, including legal
1 20 resident aliens in the United States. A business that
1 21 receives financial assistance from the department from
1 22 moneys appropriated in this bill shall only employ
1 23 individuals legally authorized to work in this state.
1 24 In addition to any and all other applicable penalties
1 25 provided by current law, all or a portion of the
1 26 assistance received by a business which has received
1 27 financial assistance and is found to knowingly employ
1 28 individuals not legally authorized to work in this
1 29 state is subject to recapture by the department.>
1 30 #2. Page 15, by inserting after line 17 the
1 31 following:
1 32 <Sec. _____. EXPENSE REIMBURSEMENT == REQUIREMENTS.
1 33 Notwithstanding any provision to the contrary, for the
1 34 fiscal year beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June
1 35 30, 2010, the director of a department or state agency
1 36 to which appropriations are made pursuant to the
1 37 provisions of this Act shall require employees, in
1 38 order to receive reimbursement for expense, to submit
1 39 actual receipts for meals and other costs and
1 40 reimbursement up to the maximum amount shall only be
1 41 allowed in an amount equal to the sum of the actual
1 42 receipts submitted.>

 1 5 #2. Page 6, by inserting after line 25 the
 1 6 following:
 1 7 <b. Paragraph "a" does not apply to a reduction
 1 8 made to support the college of veterinary medicine, if
 1 9 the same percentage of reduction imposed on the
 1 10 college of veterinary medicine is also imposed on all
 1 11 of Iowa state university's budget units.>
 1 12 #3. Page 13, by inserting after line 16 the
 1 13 following:

 1 19 30, 2010, the secretary of agriculture and the
 1 20 director of the department of natural resources shall
 1 21 require their employees, in order to receive
 1 22 reimbursement for expenses, to submit actual receipts
 1 23 for meals and other costs. The reimbursement amount
 1 24 shall not exceed the sum of the actual receipts
 1 25 submitted.>
